When are the ceremonies this year?

Saturday 18th November at The Mary Stevens Hospice starting at 5pm

Tuesday 21st November at St Mary's Church, Oldswinford starting at 7pm

Is there parking?

There will be NO parking on site for our ceremony at the Hospice, except for disabled parking.

There will be parking in front of the Church and in the surrounding streets on Tuesday 21st.

What is the difference between both ceremonies?
